#### 4. Czech Cuisine

Eating habits, typical/popular dishes (beverages, side dishes, desserts), eating out, special occasions/events, regional differences, taste and health, my eating habits.

#### 5. The UK

Location on the map, geography, parts, climate, political system, the capital, symbols, places of interest, nationalities and languages, sports, culture, personalities.

#### 6. London

Location in England, population, places of interest, transport, culture.

#### 7. Transport and Travelling in the Czech Republic

Reasons for travelling, means of transport, preferences, advantages and disadvantages of individual means of transport (comfort and speed, safety, ecology), public transport.

#### 8. The Czech Republic and Traditional Products

Czech export, typical Czech products known abroad (e.g. glass, porcelain, Bohemian garnet, Skoda cars, beer, Kofola, Becherovka/herbal bitter, Pardubice gingerbread, Petrof pianos, Bata shoes).

#### 9. My School and Education in the Czech Republic

Levels of education (pre-primary, primary, secondary, universities), types of schools, length of study, terms, holidays, subjects, exams, certificates, Creative Hill College (majors).

#### 10. The Czech Republic

Location on the map, geography, climate, parts, population, the capital, symbols, political system, places of interest, culture.

#### 11. My Region

Location on the map, landscape, places of interest, culture (traditions, events), sports, industry and agriculture, schools, typical products, food of the region.

## **12. Culture and Art in the Czech Republic**

Traditional and modern cultural events (folk festivals, film and music festivals, concerts), cultural institutions (theatres, cinemas, museums, galleries).

## **13. Famous Czech Personalities**

Important Czech scientists, artists, authors, composers, sportspeople, politicians, filmmakers, historical figures.

## **14. William Shakespeare**

The place of his birth, era, life (plays and sonnets), work, the Globe.

## **15. Anglo-American Literature**

One book by a British or American writer (title, author, genre, theme, setting, plot, characters, opinion).

## **16. The USA**

Location on the map, geography, parts, climate, political system, the capital, symbols, places of interest, nationalities and languages, sports, culture, personalities.

## **17. Prague**

Location on the map, parts, population, places of interest, transport, culture, sports.

## **18. The Media in the Czech Republic**

Role of media, types of media, broadsheets and tabloids, magazines, TV and radio broadcasting channels, popularity, content and quality, the Internet.

## **19. Canada**

Location on the map, geography, climate, political system, the capital, symbols, places of interest, nationalities and languages, sports, personalities.

## **20. Australia or New Zealand**

Location on the map, geography, climate, political system, the capital, symbols, places of interest, nationalities and languages, sports, personalities, flora and fauna.
