1. Holidays and Celebrations in the Czech Republic

Date, origin, reasons for celebrating, symbols, customs and traditions, activities, special food and drink, family traditions.

2. Holidays and Celebrations in English speaking countries

Date, origin, reasons for celebrating, symbols, customs and traditions, activities, special food and drink, family traditions.

3. British Cuisine

Typical/popular dishes (beverages, side dishes, desserts), taste and health, eating habits and traditions, eating out, special occasions/events.

4. Czech Cuisine

Typical/popular dishes (beverages, side dishes, desserts), taste and health, eating habits and traditions, eating out, special occasions/events, regional differences.

5. The UK

Places of interest, geography, the government, the Royal Family, national traditions and symbols.

6. London

The most popular and significant sights in London, the transport, traffic.

7. Transport and Traveling in the Czech Republic

Various means of transport, advantages and disadvantages of individual means of transport, public transport, traffic jams, transport and ecology.

8. The Czech Republic and Traditional Products

Typical Czech products that are known abroad, Czech glass/crystal, Skoda Plzen Train, Skoda Mlada Boleslav car, kofola, becherovka (herbal bitter), Pardubice gingerbread.

9. The Czech Republic and Education

Levels of education, types of school, branches of study, length of study, school year, holidays, timetable, subjects, exams, certificates.

10. The Czech Republic

Location, parts, regions, places of interest, historical sights, geography (climate, mountains, rivers, etc.), traveling around the Czech Republic, political system.

11. My Region

The region where I live or study: general introduction, folk traditions, places of interest, industry, agriculture, typical products and food.

12. Culture and Art in the Czech Republic

Various cultural events, film and music festivals, traditional folk festivals, the National Theatre, my region and culture.

13. Famous Czech Personalities

Personality, time, period, century, importance, historical background/events, interesting information.

14. William Shakespeare

His life and work (plays and sonnets), English Renaissance, Queen Elizabeth I, the Globe.

15. Anglo-American Literature

At least one play by William Shakespeare. One of your favourite books by a British writer of your own choice. One of your favourite books by an American writer your own choice.

16. The USA

Geography (location, climate, mountains, rivers, etc.), political systems and symbols, people (nationalities, cities, etc.), places of interest, culture, sport.

17. Prague

The population and history of Prague. The most popular and significant sights in Prague, the transport and traffic.

18. The Media in the Czech Republic

The role of media, the most common types of media, public and private sector, accessibility/popularity, costs, content and quality, history.

19. Canada

Geography, political system (symbols, history), people – nationalities, languages, cities, culture, sports

20. Australia and New Zealand

Location, landscape, climate, flora and fauna, history, people, government, flag, cities, tourist attractions
